SIA-ProD Phases


- Development of the Teacher Self-Assessment Assistant (TSAA)

Previous transnational SIA-ProD Meetings

The main discussion topics in the 3rd and 4th meeting of the SIA-ProD project were the following: a) the development and finalization of the TSAA and b) the development of the SIEP.

- In Bologna (3rd meeting), the first pilot results were presented and the pilot procedure was completed.
- In Nicosia (4th meeting), the final results were presented and the TSAA was finalized.
- In both meetings, the project members organized training seminars for the Self-improvement phase data collection for the participating early childhood educators.

In the current phase, the main study results are further analysed for dissemination purposes, and the SIEP is developed.
